To reserve your places please contact the Secretary before **Friday 12th January**, as the hotel needs to know numbers and menu choices well in advance.

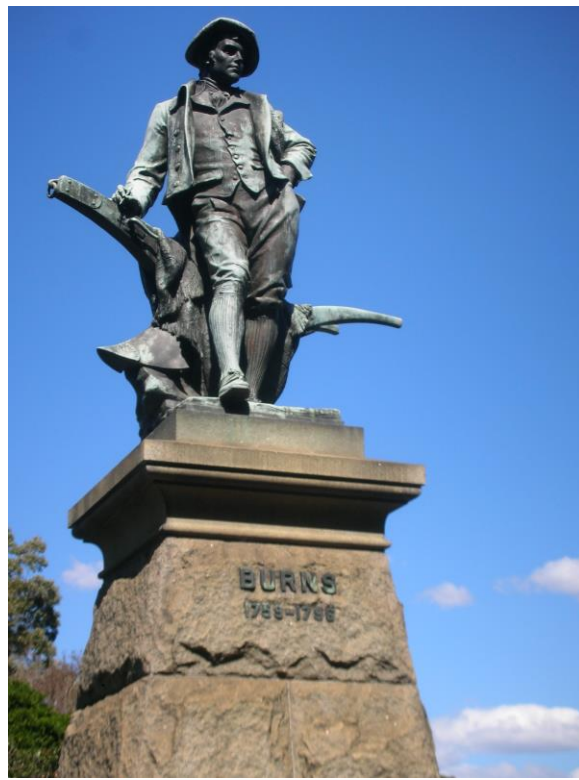
The Cottesmore Hotel (linked to the Challis Restaurant by a covered walkway) is offering accommodation to those who wish to stay overnight at £79.00 per double room and £69.00 per single room with breakfast and the use of the health club and swimming pool. Golf at guest rates. (Check in: from 2.30 pm check-out: 10.30 am.)

Please note that the Challis Restaurant is on the first floor and there is no lift.
