Directions

The Pavilion hall is on the B2110 just at the north end of the village of Handcross.

Coming from the north leave the A23 at the Handcross exit and continue until you meet the B2110 from Turners Hill at a mini roundabout. Shortly after this roundabout just as you enter the village you will see the hall on the RHS. The entrance to the car park is just a few metres further on and can be seen by the yellow height barrier over the entrance.

From the south leave the A23 at the Handcross exit and at the roundabout with the B2110 turn right over the A23 and then fork left in the centre of the village on the B2110 towards Turners Hill. Just after the

last house on the LHS you will see the yellow height barrier marking the entrance to the car park.

Walk

We plan to set off from the Pavilion at 2.30 pm.

This is an easy walk of about 3 miles with no stiles which will be led by Reg Thirkettle with Iain Millar as back marker. It is mainly along country footpaths so good walking shoes are recommended.
