SATNAV : RH19 4LF (coordinates 51.10284N, 0.05057W)

This will get you close but you will need the instructions below to find the house. It is close to Kingscote Station which is on the Bluebell Line

##### **FROM TURNER'S HILL**

Take the B2110 past the Alexander House Hotel towards East Grinstead. Just after passing under the railway take the turning on the **RIGHT** signposted to Kingscote station and West Hoathly. Just after passing under the railway again you will come to Kingscote station. Tickeridge barn is the first turning on the **RIGHT** .

No.2 is up the drive on the **LEFT**. Drive into the farmyard and turn right to park in front of the barn.
