Following the success of the venue for the last four years we will be returning to Wivelsfield Village Hall. The catering this year will be provided by Louise's Kitchen.

As St Andrew's is one of the two formal major annual events in the Society's calendar, we look forward to seeing as many members as possible. Relatives and friends are very welcome at this event and members are encouraged to bring guests. Also, please remember to bring your own wine and glasses to accompany the meal.

The subsidised cost will be £30.00 per head, which includes a welcome drink.

There will be a choice of three main courses:
